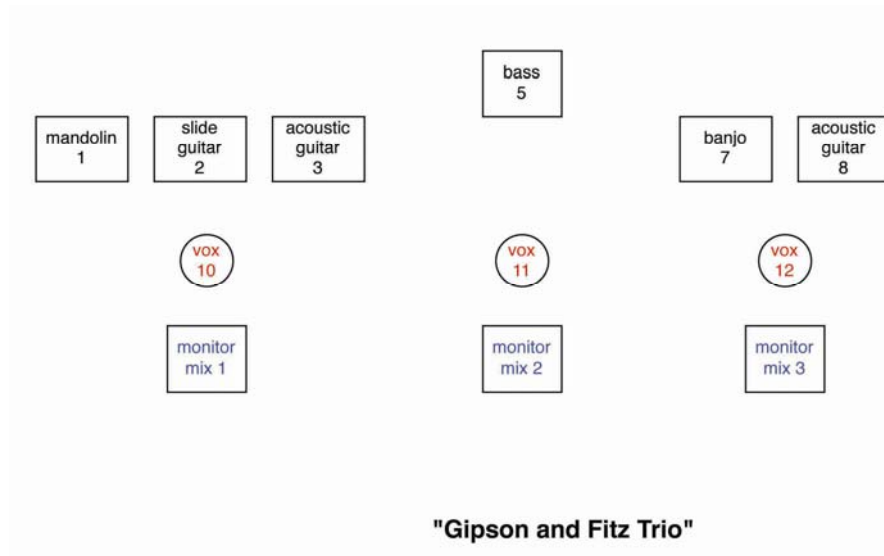

Input list for accompanying stage plot:

- Inputs 1 – 8: DI Boxes for inputs 1- 8 will all be provided by the Gipson and Fitz Trio, with the exception of input 2 for which a DI Box will need to be provided.
- Inputs 10-12: Shure Beta 58 or comparable/superior vocal microphones will be required for inputs 10 -12.
- The contracted sound company will need to supply a balanced XLR cable to run from all DI Boxes to the destination snake and/or soundboard.



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
